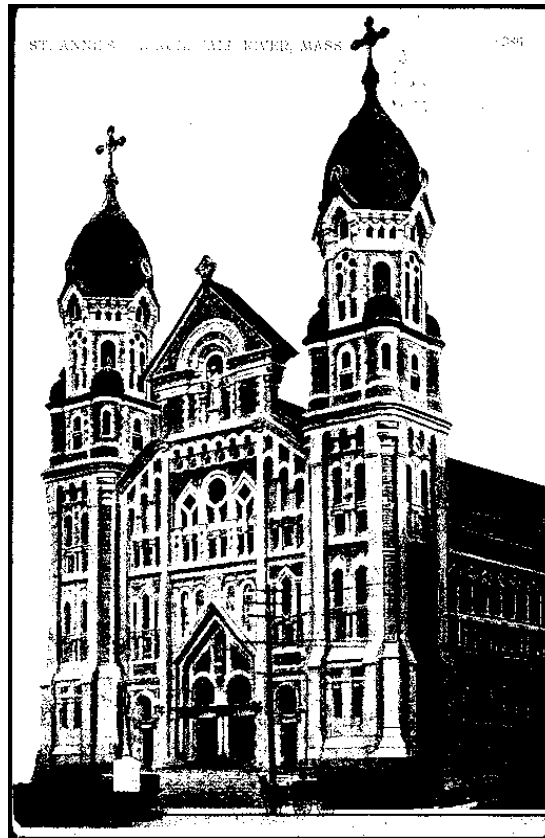


Solemn Novena Devotions
