

Liturgical accomplishments

- Continued the restoring tradition of the Shrine with monthly Healing Masses, provided by Shrine Chaplain Fr. Edward A. Murphy
- Introduced people to the tradition of Solemn Vespers in November (for the feast of All Souls' Day) and during Lent
- Hosted the Life in the Spirit Seminar during November and December, through which the Shrine's Tuesday prayer group blossomed
- Cultivated a renewed love for the Eucharist in the spirit of the USCCB's national Eucharistic Revival through monthly Holy Hours, catechesis, and Corpus Christic celebrations
- Hosted the 151st Annual Novena & Feast of St. Anne on July 17-26 with record turnout during all ten days
- Encouraging an uptick in pilgrimages to the Shrine from across the nation and throughout the world, including pilgrims from the states of Virginia, Indiana, and Kansas, and the countries of Canada, Portugal, and Sri Lanka

Looking ahead...

- Instilling a weekly time for the Sacrament of Reconciliation during a weekday evening, with the help of retired priests
- Returning Eucharistic Adoration to the Shrine with the installation of the Adoration Chapel in the lower church
- Welcoming outside ministries & events to be hosted at the Shrine, continuing its use as a space Catholics across the Diocese and beyond can share for spiritual growth

Structural accomplishments

- Initiated roof & gutter repairs, including: reassessing damage for accurate repair, replacing the copper ridge & slates, and clearing clogged downspouts
- Installed 4 sump pumps to control flooding in the lower church
- Restored the St. Joseph Chapel, the Santo Christo dos Milagres Chapel, and the lower church sacristy
- Improved building accessibility by building new concrete steps & railings near the parking lot
- Purchased & installed a new electronic carillon bell system, announcing the presence of the Shrine in the community

Looking ahead...

- Completing the Eucharistic adoration chapel in the lower church
- Completing the restoration of the Dominican Crypt Chapel, where 3 of the Shrine's Dominican Fathers were laid to rest
- Continuing and completing major roof & gutter repairs on the north and south sides of the building




